Lots of thank you's from admin to PTO (meals, equipment)
Encouraging all staff members to be part of PTO - there will be grade level competition for that
Enrollment projected 1200; actual 1150
The vacancies are: 1 facilitator and the 6th grade admin
We have full time nurse, CTE coordinator, psychologist, social worker, speech pathologist
He feels very confident that we are fully staffed
38 buses for 913 students - some of those buses run multiple routes, that can take until 6:30pm
before everyone leaves campus
Car riders and walkers - 207
iReady testing starts Monday
There will be some overlap
Dr. Turner's ties are tight to RMS - he was AP here years ago, his brother and sister both served
as AP's here
Wants to help us improve the letter grade of school, make sure there is a plan for teachers and
for students to get that grade up to A/B - not a C which it is currently. That is the priority.
Dr. Turner will stay through October to oversee/help with transition.
Dr. Turner and AP Green are formally observing and reviewing every single teacher

AP teacher at Audrey Kell, then Dean of Students at Myers Park, then AP at Lake Norman
Charter School (he loves middle school teacher and kids), then Bradford High School
Family military background
Priorities -

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Safe, secure learning environment for kids, build our trust. Physically, socially, emotionally.
High expectations - being present, knowing names, responsive
School has good bones, rich history, strong PTO
This is a leaders dream - so let him know what we want
Teacher retention important
Shared story about getting to know Piedmont IB principal and friendly competition
Friendly, dependable leadership

Implementing remediation plans for students who need it
Improve test taking skills daily
