Question 1 - elective teachers are overwhelmed, how can we help them? A - give grace with grading and understand they have double the amount of kids from last year; and then come January we need to take a look to make a change
Further question to that is chorus/music? A - Our enrollment numbers have dropped so we have lost a few teacher allocations; Mavity is working to fix this and get a qualified sub in there, he is committed but working progress
Question 2 - what is going on with behavior management? A - starts with leadership and coaching to equip teachers to be their best; we may be bogged down with tier 1 issues; they are eating up higher level admin time; creating an 'on call' system for admins throughout school so that folks can focus and run around putting out fires; want to have higher level admin helping out with content in the classroom
Question 3 - Extensions Program is one of best in the district; can we further integrate extensions students into our greater student population; a more cohesive environment
Question 4 - Updates on staffing. A - Ms. Barrow is starting as assistant principal for 6th grade this week; Attendance Secretary starts this week; Music/Chorus to come; Ms. Hines/CTE just left and interviews are coming shortly
