 - Scheduling changes

 - Mr. Davis is testing coordinator FYI
 - Primary reason for scheduling changes - Raider time has been added to each core block, 20 min to ensure kids are ready for testing. Core classes are 80 minutes not 60 minutes. The first 20 minutes of class is testing prep and the last 60 min is lesson based. Utilizing all the staff possible to teach kids, especially those who need the most help. During this 20 minute time the kids are working on a variety of different lessons/ levels of the software based on if they are at, below or above grade level.
 - It also helps with keeping each grade level in different parts of the building throughout the day.
 - Ms. Johnson is teacher of year - 8th grade path
 - Ms. Powell is assistant of the year
 - March 10 Benchmark 2, iReady Feb 23 week
 - NAEP for 8th grade only on March 9
 - Mavity emphasizes yes testing is important but also wants to keep a balance, keep kids interested, keep in mind the whole child and not overtest... or at least incentivize them to do their best
 - Question - concerns about the overload of testing this week ie 8th grade has testing in all core subject this Thursday and Friday - that is VERY difficult on the kids; Mavity emphasizes that we/school staff need to be better aware of this - the weather messed with this recently but still we have responsibility to manage it better
 - Staffing update - music is still open, the hope is to have Lancaster full time next year; could use another ESL teacher; one Horizons position open as well, but CMS hires for that
 - Question - concern about testing on Mondays, particularly for 6th graders with developing learning skills
